<p><b>Democracy</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• We encourage children to have an opinion and listen to others' points of view.</li><li>• We encourage children to take turns, share, work together and problem solve as a group.</li><li>• We encourage children to ask questions and value the questions they ask.</li><li>• We support children to understand that everyone has a voice and is listened to.</li><li>• We support children's ideas and requests regarding changes to the environment.</li><li>• We treat all the children equally.</li><li>• We encourage children to make choices about how they would like to use resources.</li><li>• We encourage the children to develop enquiring minds allowing them to extend activities.</li></ul>	<p><b>Rule of Law</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• We support children with understanding their own behaviours and emotions and those of others.</li><li>• We support children in distinguishing between right and wrong.</li><li>• We involve the children in devising our golden rules.</li><li>• We support children to manage and resolve their own disagreements.</li><li>• We support children in understanding and implementing the rules of our forest school sessions</li></ul>
<p><b>Individual Liberty</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• We allow children to solve problems, make choices and take risks in a safe, well-managed environment.</li><li>• We celebrate children's achievements with WOW moments.</li><li>• We are sympathetic to children's feelings and provide reassurance by acknowledging and talking about their emotions.</li><li>• We celebrate everyone's birthdays.</li><li>• We do not force a child to join in with activities if they do not wish to.</li><li>• We support children to become independent in their self-care skills.</li></ul>	<p><b>Mutual Respect and Tolerance</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• We encourage children to learn about similarities and differences between themselves and others.</li><li>• We support children's understanding that they are part of a wider world through our trips and experiences within the community.</li><li>• We create an ethos of inclusivity and tolerance where all views, races, faiths and cultures are valued.</li><li>• We support children to make relationships, manage their own feelings and behaviour.</li><li>• We support children with turn-taking.</li><li>• We celebrate children's achievements.</li><li>• We challenge negative perceptions and stereotyping through role modelling and within play experiences.</li></ul>
